Construction Update

May 1st we're 214 days from our first service in our new sanctuary!!!! But who's counting? We continue to get word from you and our community about how the building is coming up and how exciting this is! The floors, walls and ceilings continue to become more and more defined and the space is truly taking shape! Now that the roof is on, the exterior walls are priority. You can see metal framing going up around the perimeter of the building this month. Following the metal framing will be the masonry block and brick. Many of the interior walls will be framed as well so that the rough in for electrical and plumbing can continue. Southern Air has hung the ductwork in the sanctuary and will be moving to the other parts of the building next. The month of May will see the site work come to target grade. Inside the building the floor system for the stage will arrive and installation begin, the rise and run steps and seating platforms for the tiered seating will arrive and installation begin. Finally, the main level floor that connects the existing building to the new sanctuary will be poured in concrete.

We are at a stage in this

project that I'd like to let you know of some items that need your prayers and financial support. When we closed the loan with Bank of the West, to help balance the sources of funds and the uses of those funds, we had to remove some items from the project that are not essential to getting a



Certificate of Occupancy. These items will need to be funded before we can secure their purchase and installation. We will try to have pricing of these items for our "Finishing Strong" dinner Sunday evening May 17th. Mark your calendars as you don't want to miss out on what God's done in our campaign and the

building project.

Praise God for all that He is doing through His people! As we approach the arrival into our new sanctuary and the close of this campaign, I'm reminded of how we began this journey of faith. It was a step of faith then, and is even a greater step now. However, with

all that is changing in our world, our God is not. He is the author and perfecter of our faith. Let us remain steadfast in Him and watch Him perfect our faith. And remember, this building
